

TRAVEL INFORMATION FOR BRIDLINGTON SPA

TRAIN

There is a train ramp at Bridlington station to get on and off the trains. This station only has tactile paving on platforms 5 & 6. There is level access to platforms 5 & 6 (Hull), but access to platform 4 (Scarborough) is accessible via a locked barrow crossing during staffed hours only. Please allow a minimum of ten minutes prior to your train's departure if you need to use the barrow crossing. If you are unable to use the stairs and wish to use platform 4 after the ticket office has closed, please call Assisted Travel on 0800 138 5560 for advice on alternative accessible transport arrangements.

There are accessible drop off or pick up points at this station. There is step free access from the car park to the station entrance and there are wheelchairs available at this station.

There is a taxi rank at the station although it is recommended to order taxis in advance to avoid disappointment. Taxi companies in Bridlington with accessible taxis include; Willerby Arrow Private Hire, East Coast Private Hire, and Brid Cars. Or you can pre-arrange an accessible taxi through Bridlington Station by calling customer experience on 0800 200 6060.

There are no accessible toilets at Bridlington Station, and no accessible public telephones. There are staff available to help during working hours.

BUS

The closest bus stop is approximately 250 metres north of Bridlington Spa on South Cliff Road.

The only bus from Bridlington Bus Station that stops there is the 136 bus to Driffield. The 136 leaves from Bay A1 at Bridlington Bus Station, and South Cliff Road is one of its earliest stops.

From South Cliff Road Bus Stop, you can follow South Marine Drive until you reach Bridlington Spa.

CAR

Parking

Parking is available at Langdale Wharf Harbour Car Park located 300 metres north of Bridlington Spa. Please note, there are two car parks at Langdale Wharf, be sure to purchase your ticket from the correct machine.

Alternatively, there is both pay-and-display and free on-street parking on South Marine Drive south of the venue.

There are eight disabled bays on the Promenade, accessed via the slip road north of Bridlington Spa. They offer both stepped and step-free access to the building however, step-free access requires users to return to the top of the inclined slip road then turn left and walk along South Marine Drive to the main entrance at the south end of the venue.

If you think you may require help getting from your vehicle please contact Bridlington Spa before the event and we will do our utmost to help however; we may not be able to provide prompt assistance for some very large events.

Drop Off Zone

You may drop passengers off at the kerbside in front of Bridlington Spa's main entrance but you must not leave your vehicle unattended. This provision is to allow passengers to disembark before going to park the vehicle elsewhere.

The same area can be used for collection at the end of an event but waiting vehicles should not cause unnecessary obstruction to the flow of traffic. If this happens, then please drive around the block and return or move to a safer location.

For some events you may not be able to park directly outside of the main entrance for safety and security reasons.

DIRECTIONS

To get to Bridlington Spa from Bridlington Bus Station, turn into Princess Terrace before turning left into Marshall Avenue. Follow the road before turning right onto Chapel Street. Follow Chapel Street before turning left into Manor Street. Follow the road before turning right into Bridge Street and then follow the road before turning left onto South Cliff Road. Follow South Cliff road until you reach South Marine Drive and then follow until you reach the Spa.

To get to Bridlington Spa from Bridlington Train Station, the fastest route is to leave Bridlington Station through Station approach and exit onto Hilderthorpe Road. From here, turn right before crossing to New Burlington Road. Follow New Burlington Road down until you reach West Street, then turn left. Follow West Street and then turn right into Neptune Street. Follow Neptune Street down into Horsforth Avenue and continue towards the bend in the road, turning left until you reach South Marine Drive. The Spa will be directly ahead.

To get to Bridlington Bus Station from Bridlington Train Station, the fastest route is to follow Station Approach Road up until you reach Quay Road. Follow Quay Road onto Prospect Street before turning left onto Chapel Street. Follow Chapel Street before turning left onto Marshall Avenue and then follow this road until the right turn for Princess Terrace, where you will find the bus stop.
